

Mr. Kohlenberg's Construction Rules, Procedures & Expectations (RPE's)

Rules

1. Be on class on time and be ready to work.
2. BYOP – Bring your own pencils!!!
3. Complete all assignments given with best effort.
4. Respect each other, be polite and helpful. Bullying will not be tolerated.
5. Mr. Kohlenberg's office is off limits. Please admire from afar!
6. No record players, 8-tracs, cassette players, walkmans, ipods, mp3's, etc. allowed.
7. No cell phones.
8. No food or drink.

Procedures

1. Arrive in front of the Construction shop and wait to enter.
2. When you arrive into the shop, grab your duo tang and go over to the tables and wait for further instruction. (Class time is *YOUR* time - the longer it takes to begin, the less time you will have to work on projects.)
3. If you need to use the washroom, please ask for permission to leave.
4. If you need a drink of water please ask for permission to leave.
5. You will be allowed 5-7 minutes at the end of each class to clean up. All materials / tools must be put away and the shop must be clean before the class is to be dismissed.
6. At the end of the period, you are to remain in the classroom area until I dismiss the class.

Shop Drawing, Tool Identification, Measurement Activity, Safety Test.


3. Project 50%

Teacher professional judgement will be used to determine final student grade based on best student evidence.

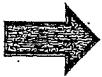
